You are cordially invited to attend an outcomes assessment workshop focusing on the assessment of General Education learning objectives. This session will be based on a highly praised workshop developed by two faculty who have been actively involved in outcomes assessment activities. They will focus on both direct and indirect assessment of student learning.

Presenters are Mary Allen and Richard Noel.

Mary Allen is Director of the Faculty Teaching and Learning Center, Director of Assessment, and Professor of Psychology at CSUB. She holds a master's in statistics and a Ph.D. in psychology from U.C., Berkeley. Her academic background is in psychometrics, statistics, and research methods. She coordinates the Program Assessment Consultation Team (PACT), a group that supports campus outcomes assessment efforts at CSUB. She helped develop and facilitate two system-wide conferences on outcomes assessment, including last year's GE assessment conference.

Richard Noel is Associate Director of the Faculty Teaching and Learning Center, PACT's Qualitative Research Coordinator, and a Professor of Psychology at CSUB. He holds a Ph.D. in social psychology from the University of Colorado. His academic background is in social psychology and small group dynamics. With Mary Allen, he has conducted outcomes assessment workshops and consultations for a variety of CSU audiences.
